## Communion Ministers



In addition to assisting the priest with the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass once or twice a month, members of this ministry may be trained to bring the consecrated host to members of the parish who cannot attend mass. This could include visitation in hospitals, nursing homes and assisted living facilities. Extraordinary ministers also bring Holy



Communion to the home-bound and the elderly.

Extraordinary Ministers of Communion can also lead the congregation in Communion services. This requires further training and the approval of the pastor.
